Final Project

Points of Interest:

1. Folder, sub-folder & files appropriately named for clarity & ownership.
2. Appropriate use of stills.
3. Appropriate Theme/Idea.
4. A well-defined project storyboard created and printed from Inspiration.
5. Appropriate use of **Sound Companion 2** to create the sound track (WAV) files. (These files individually imported into QuickTime Pro can have their volumes adjusted INDIVIDUALLY!) **Be sure to set the Windows CD Microphone properly – See Sound Companion Booklet 1.**
 - Create multiple sound files –
 - Voice Overs volume set at Level 7.
 - CD Audio Tracks recorded at Level 3 – 4.
 - MIDI Files recorded at Level 3 – 4.
 - Appropriate timing of sound tracks.
 - Music/Sound/Voice matches the scene, blends in to enhance the scene action.
6. **Appropriate use of video:**
 - Original – appropriate action that shows a well thought plot was well rehearsed and enhances the production.
 - Additional Source – avoided plagiarism and did not take up more than one fourth of final production.
7. Demonstrates a good use of **Videowave** to combine stills, transitions, special effects & text:
 - Good use of stills (set for at least five seconds).
 - Appropriate scene transitions.
 - Appropriate special effects – not too many ...not to little...enhances the final production.
 - Produce project as an MPEG-1 movie file.
8. Appropriate use of **Paint Shop Pro:**
 - Create a blank JPEG file for use in Videowave for text use and production credits.
 - Modify and enhance stills and other photos.
9. Appropriate use of **QuickTime Pro:**
 - Open movie as an MPEG.
 - Add various sound files as Audio File:
 - ◆ Must make sure that the dark triangle is at a place where you want to insert your audio file/sound track.
 - Timing is important – must coordinate sound track(s) with movie length for appropriate sequence.
